FACILITATED ENROLLMENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Facilitated Enrollment Scholarship Program (FESP) is a pilot project funded by the New York State Legislature and administered by the Consortium for Worker Education (CWE). The project provides financial support for working families to help cover child care costs.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Working parents earning more than 85% of State Medium Income (SMI), but less than 400% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) (see chart)
- Episodic workers
- Undocumented children

If your income is below the scholarship's minimum, you may still be eligible for assistance through the Administration for Children's Services (ACS).

THE GOALS OF THE PROGRAM

- Expand access to child care assistance to families who have been unable to receive assistance
- Help parents to afford licensed, quality child care and after school programs
- Support child care providers by delivering payments at up to 100% of the New York State Market Rates
